Jr. Whaler, Jr. Zodiac and AL Motor Boat Usage Policy

- JR. Whaler – located in the water on the RC Dock, light blue inside hull. Keys are located in RC Shack above door.
- JR. AL motor boat – located in the water on a ramp. Kill switch located in the RC Shack.
- JR. Zodiac – located under the car port back of B lot. 1 7/8" hitch required to launch it. ****permission needed****

Primary Purpose of the Jr. Program motor boats:

The LLSC Jr. Motor boats will be used for the purposes for serving the training needs of the LLSC Jr. Sailing Program and the safe sailing needs of our junior sailors. These boats should only be used to support these specific activities.

Uses of the Motor boats that are explicitly approved by the LLSC Jr. Director:

- During LLSC training classes driven by US Sailing Certified Instructors.
- During Youth events and regattas hosted by LLSC
- LLSC Fleet Races if no training conflict exists.
- LLSC Team Racing events.
- LLSC Member Adults (18+) that have been checked out for skill test may use the boats without supervision to support the training and safety needs of the LLSC Jr. Sailors.
- Priority is always given to Scheduled Junior Events. Please check calendar.

Rules:

- Lifejackets are required to be worn by all instructors while teaching classes or lessons. **No exceptions.**
- Kill Switches must be worn at all times. **No Exceptions.**
- Please respect the equipment and put it back in BETTER shape than you found it.
- Any missing or lost parts should be reported to the Jr. Director ASAP, llscjrsailing@gmail.com .
- No towing of anything or anyone except a sailboat permitted. **No Exceptions.**
- GA DNR requires all boat drivers to carry their drivers license while operating a boat.
- GA DNR requires all boaters under the age of 13 to have a lifejacket on.
- Failure to follow these rules will be subject to all boat privileges from being taken away.
