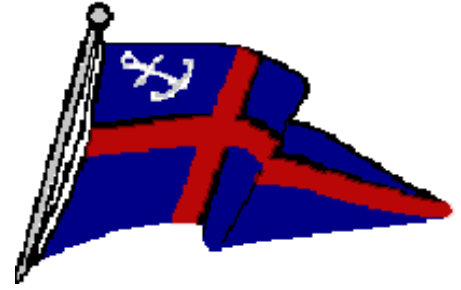


Notice of Race
2016 Les Storrs Series
Honoring Les Storrs, SCCYC Commodore, 1936
Saturday, March 19, 2016
Marina del Rey, California
ASMBYC High Point



Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing. The PHRF Marine Professional rule does not apply.

Eligibility: All keelboats and center board boats. Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and racing a boat that is a member of the class or fleet in which it competes. Entrants in the PHRF classes must have a 2015 or 2016 PHRF certificate.

Classes: Classes will be established based upon the number of paid entrants as of 9:00 AM on the day of the race. A minimum of three boats will establish a class. Five boats in a class will get a separate start. One Design Classes are encouraged to have a representative contact PRO, Bruce Fleck at (310) 600 5214 or SCBruceFleck@gmail.com.

We hope to have a Cruising Class with an appropriate course.

Entries: Entries must be received by the day of the race before 9:00 AM. The entry fee is as follows:

Under 22 feet \$25

22 to 29 feet \$35

Over 30 feet \$45

Checks should be made payable to SCCYC. Race entries shall be submitted via regatta-network.

Sailing Instructions/Class Flags: Sailing Instructions and class flags will be available at SCCYC.org no later than 2000 hours on the Friday before the race.

Starting Time & Location: The 1st race will start at **1300 hours**, with the Warning Signal at 1255 hours in the vicinity of "S" mark.

Courses: Courses will be chosen from SCCYC Les Storrs 2016 Course chart that will be included with the sailing instructions and will be available for download at <http://www.sccyc.org>. Classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as the weather allows. The RC hopes to run four races and finish racing by 1700 hours. Cruising Class will run no more than two races.

Series Scoring: Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with no throw outs, will be used.

Appendix T Section A and C are in force. (if an incident occurs outside the zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty shall be one turn including one tack and one gybe. And Expedited hearings)

Trophies: Commemorative Les Storrs Trophy Glasses will be awarded to all participants at the Awards Ceremony at SCCYC. Top Finishers will receive more than one depending on the number of entrants. Must be present to collect.

Hospitality: As is tradition, racers eat for free, no host bar.
