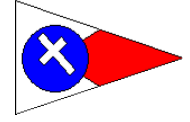

NOTICE OF RACE



2016 MOORE 24 Regatta
April 30 & May 1, 2016

1 Rule

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Rule 40 will be changed to require competitors to wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will alter RRS rule 44.1 replacing a two-turns penalty with a one-turn penalty.
- 1.4 Changes to the rules will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Boats of the Moore 24 class are eligible to participate in this regatta.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at [Moore 24 Regatta](#). Only on-line entries will be accepted.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The regular non refundable entry fee is \$125.00 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hour on Wednesday, April 27, 2016.
- 3.2 The entry fee of \$150.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Wednesday, April 27, 2016.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1000 hours on Saturday, April 30, 2016.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors' meeting is scheduled for 1030 hours on Saturday, April 30, 2016 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1230 hours Saturday and 1200 hours Sunday.
- 4.3 Six races (6) are scheduled. Three races on Saturday and three races on Sunday.
- 4.4 Three (3) races will constitute a regatta.
- 4.5 No warning signal will be made after 1530 hours on Sunday May 1, 2016.
- 4.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse on Sunday May 1, 2016 following racing.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The sailing instructions may be available at the competitors' meeting and on line at scyc.org.

6 Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys and fixed buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

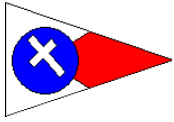
- 7.1 A course diagram will be provided in the sailing instructions.

8 Courses

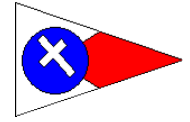
- 8.1 Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

Supplemental Information:

Trailer Parking: Trailers cannot be parked in regular parking spaces. See enclosed parking map.

Trailers are required to be parked in the trailer turn around area adjacent to the bathrooms, or in the SCYC dry storage yard. If this area is full, trailers shall be parked in the Santa Cruz Harbor Trailer yard located on the corner of 7th Avenue and Brommer. See enclosed parking map.

Cars: Park only in visitor parking spaces. Please do not risk a ticket – pay at parking pay stations before you leave your vehicles.

Berthing:

One end-tie will be available to competitors, see enclosed map for location.
