Notice of Race Rev 2016-05-24

- 1. Rules
 - 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of United States Sailing Association (US Sailing), the rules of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA), and this Notice of Race, except as these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any Appendices to the Sailing Instructions.
 - 1.2 The Organizing Authority is the ILCA and the Bellport Bay Yacht Club. The event will be held at Bellport Bay Yacht Club, Bellport, NY.
 - 1.3 This Regatta is designated as **Category C** in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.

2. Language

The official language for this Regatta is English.

- 3. Eligibility and Entry
 - 3.1 Laser Standard, Radial and 4.7 competitors who are members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association may enter by completing registration <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/12285</u>. A minimum of five entries are required to constitute a class.

4. Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to this event. This includes on-shore activities before, during and after the regatta.

5. Schedule of Events

Friday, June 10, 2016 Registration 0900 to 2000 hrs

First Race Warning Signal 1100 hrs

Racing will continue until late afternoon – Lunch snack supplied on water Dinner after racing ends for the day

Sunday, June 12, 2016

First Race Warning Signal 1100 hrs

Racing will continue - No Race Warning Signal after 1500 hrs Awards to follow after Last Race.

6. Fees

- 6.1 Registration Fee of \$100.00 per competitor through Regatta Network
- 6.2 The entry fee will include Breakfast, Snack on the Water during racing (Fruit, Power Bars and Water), and Dinner Saturday Night and a Regatta Souvenir (Shirt).

7. Sailing Instructions

7.1 Sailing Instructions will be available from Friday, June 10 until Saturday June 11 at the Registration desk inside the Yacht Club.

8. Courses and Racing Area

- 8.1 Courses will be the Standard ILCA Trapezoid Course as described in ILCA-NA Regatta Guidelines with Races approximately 50 to 60 minutes long.
- 8.2 The Racing area will be on Bellport Bay (the Eastern End of Great South Bay) just South of the Bellport Bay Yacht Club, end of Bellport Lane, Bellport, NY 11713 (Chart attached)
- 8.3 For better Race Management the Race Committee reserves the right to split one or both Laser Standard or Laser Radial fleets into two divisions or flights with separate starts for each division or flight.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS, Appendix A4, will apply, except that a yacht's worst score will be excluded from a yacht's total score if a minimum of 5 races have been completed (This changes Appendix A2 RRS).
- 9.2 **Seven (7)** Races are scheduled. A minimum of **3** races must be completed to constitute a Regatta.

10. RRS 42 (propulsion) and other Infringements

10.1 There will be Judges on the Water during Racing and RRS Appendix P will be in effect.

11. Additional Information

Additional Information on Lodging will be attached to this NOR for release to Regatta Network. **There will be No Camping on Village Parks within the Village.**



VILLAGE REGULATIONS ARE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

Bellport Village marina facilities and dockside property and are generously offered to sailors and guests as a courtesy to BBYC. The BBYC officers and race officials, or the dock masters provide assistance. Please follow the regulations.

- 1. No consumption or carrying of opened alcoholic beverages at anytime.
- 2. Parking is limited to behind the bandstand or on Bellport Lane.
- 3. No parking at any time on Shore Road.
- 4. Cars with empty trailers must park in the lot on Shore Road, east of the guard booth.
- 5. No boats may be tied in slips or block slips at any time. Boats may be anchored off Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights.
- 6. Boats may tie on the south side of the main dock and bulkhead using a stern anchor.
- 7. Small boats may be left overnight on the beach.
- 8. Sleeping or pitching tents on Village property is prohibited.
