- **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** Copies will be available at registration.
- **6. COURSES** Courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward.
- **7. SCORING** Scoring will be according to the Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A, except all races will be scored which changes RRS A2. Five races are scheduled with one race constituting a regatta.
- **8. PRIZES** Trophies will be awarded to the top five boats, skipper and one crew.
- **9. RADIOS** As a courtesy, the Race Committee will use Channel 71 to provide information to competitors. After the starting signal, the Race Committee will attempt to hail boats via VHF and voice that are OCS and boats that have not complied with RRS 30.1.

- **12.** <u>Friday On-Water Clinic</u> Boats will meet on the water at 1300 (or whenever you are able to come out) to enjoy a clinic by Brian Hayes from North Sails. We will have practice starts and practice races. Bring your VHF radio (Ch 71). At 1630 there will be a de-brief at the clubhouse lower level.
- **13.** <u>Friday Swap Meet</u> Clean out your garage, sail locker, back of your suburban. Bring your parts, sails, pfd's for swap or sale during the swap meet at 1600. Lake Norman Community Sailing (LNCS) will be available to accept donations and/or buy your used but good condition/serviceable sails. In the past, LNCS buys good used sails for \$200 or less; Donors will receive a donation letter for tax purposes.
