# NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, by the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

- **1.1** Racing rule 52 will be changed as follows: The use of powered winches is authorized.
- **1.2** Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.
- **1.3** 6.4 Redress: RRS 60, 63.2, 63.4 USSailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.
- **1.4** Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.

Advertising will not be restricted.

## 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all yachts with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority. All yachts must meet the current ISAF cat 4 safety regulations.
