## NOTICE OF RACE

## 1 RULES

Racing shall be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes, provided six (6) or more paid registrations are received by 1200 hours on Friday, 24 June 2016:

Alerion Express 28

J/80

- 2.2 Additional classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 1200 hours on Friday, 19 June 2016.
- 2.3 The fee is:
  - \$65 for entries received by 2000 hours on Friday, 17 June 2016.
  - \$85 for entries received after 2000 hours on Friday, 17 June 2016, but before 1200 hours on Friday, 24 June 2016.
  - → Deduct \$5 for each membership in CBYRA and/or USSA.
- 2.4 A 50% entry fee refund will be granted if the request is received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 18 June 2016.

## 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Wednesday, 08 June 2016, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

#### 5 VENUE

- 5.1 Racing area will be on the Chesapeake Bay, in the vicinity of the mouth of the Severn River.
- 5.2 A post-racing party and awards presentation will be held at the EYC clubhouse after the conclusion of racing.

#### 6 COURSES

Competitors will sail drop mark courses as shown in the Sailing Instructions.

### 7 PENALTY SYSTEM

When a rule of Part 2 is broken outside the zone at a mark, and there is no injury or damage, and no significant advantage is gained, the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. This changes RRS 44.1.

## 8 SCORING

RRS Appendix A4, the Low Point System, will apply. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.

## 9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes in each class will be as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place for six (6) or more entries;
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place seven (7) or more entries;
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place for ten (10) or more entries.
- 9.2 An awards party will be held at EYC after racing. Prizes will be awarded at the party.

## 10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the One-Design Classic entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4. The organizing authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

#### 11 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

#### 12 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- This is a Clean Regatta. All competitors are strongly encouraged to use multi-use water bottles instead of disposable water bottles, and to recycle whenever possible. RRS 55 prohibits placing trash in the water.
