

PARKING

- Please park only in striped parking spots in the beach parking lot, or in the large grass overflow parking area.
- Please DO NOT park in spaces reserved for marina tenants, in the fire lane (red-striped road leading to beach), or in the parking lot in front of the Sternwheeler Dock, Locks Waterfront Grill, and
- RVs and campers are not allowed to park in the beach parking lot.

MISCELLANEOUS

- The entrance to Marine Park is height-limited by a train trestle at 12 foot clearance.
- The Port and CGRA are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Trash and recycling bins are available on site; please dispose of your waste responsibly.
- Do not prop open the gate at the marina.
- Park hours: The Marine Park is closed between 10pm and ½ hour before sunrise, except to paid campers.
- Unauthorized vehicles, trailers, or boats left unattended may be subject to towing and/or fine.
- · Bins are available for secure overnight storage in the CGRA container.

TRAILER PARKING

- Trailers may not be stored in automobile parking spaces.
- Trailer parking in the grass overflow parking area is available.
- A trailer fee of \$5/day can be paid online with event registration, at the CGRA office, or at the Port office. Valid trailer tags must be affixed to the trailer.

- · Campground reservations can be made between Memorial Day through Labor Day by calling 509-637-6911.
- All non-reserved campground sites are first-come first-served until sold out. Sites are \$30/night for hook-ups and \$20/night for tent sites. Campsites do not have fire pits. Quiet hours are from 10pm to 7am.
- · An overflow camping grass area is available for designated CGRA events only (no utilities or reservations) for \$12/tent.
- · Camp in designated areas only. No camping is allowed in parking lots, beach, or pavilion area,
- · Showers & restrooms are open to the public. Showers are available for \$3 per person for non-campers.
- An RV dump station is located in the campground, Dump fee is \$7 for non-campers.
