1 RULES

Racing shall be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes:

- 2.2 Additional classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 2000 hours on Sunday, 22 May 2016.
- 2.3 The fee is:
 - \$50 for entries received by 2000 hours on Thursday, 19 May 2016.
 - \$65 for entries received after 2000 hours on Thursday, 19 May 2016, but before 1200 hours on Thursday, 26 May 2016.
 - → Deduct \$5 for each membership in CBYRA and/or USSA.
- 2.4 A 50% entry fee refund will be provided if the request is received by 2000 hours on Sunday, 22 May 2016.

- 3.2 There will be a mandatory check-in requirement for all competitors prior to their start.
- 3.3 The starting order will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Sunday, 15 May 2016, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

5 VENUE

- 5.1 Racing will be on the Miles River, Eastern Bay, and Chesapeake Bay.
- 5.2 A post-race party and awards presentation will be held at the EYC clubhouse after the conclusion of racing.

6 COURSE

The course will be a point-to-point race between St. Michael's and Annapolis.

7 PRIZES

- 7.1 Prizes in each class will be as follows:
 - 1st Place for six (6) or more entries;
 - 2nd Place for seven (7) or more entries;
 - 3rd Place for nine (9) or more entries;
 - 4th Place for eleven (11) or more entries.
- 7.2 Prizes will be awarded during a party at EYC on Sunday, 29 May 2016.

Competitors participate in Hospice Cup entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4. The organizing authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

9 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

10 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 10.1 This is a Clean Race. All competitors are strongly encouraged to use multi-use water bottles instead of disposable water bottles, and to recycle whenever possible. RRS 55 prohibits placing trash in the water.
