### 1. Organizing Authorities

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

### 2. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the West Florida PHRF Class Rules. This is a category 5 event per WFPHRF class rules for the race in the Bay. Random Leg Rating will apply.

# 3. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all WFPHRF boats, Multihulls, and Portsmouth boats. PHRF Fleets include: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Racer Cruiser, Cruiser, Pocket Cruiser & Multihull. Three boats will constitute a class for awards. All boats whether in a class or not are eligible for the Queen of the Bay Trophy. Portsmouth fleets include any boats with a Portsmouth rating and any Portsmouth fleets with 3 or more boats will be also scored separately and together.

### 4. Registration & Fees

4.1 Registration is \$40 per boat. All registrations received from April 18th to April 23rd will be charged a
\$25 late fee. Registration fee includes 1 dinner ticket and complimentary refreshments.
4.2 Online Registration is available at regattanetwork.com. Extra dinner tickets are also available through the online registration.

# 5. Ratings and Class Rules

Boats sailing in the PHRF fleets must have a valid WFPHRF certificate and have a copy of the certificate available. Rating certificates are available online at westfloridaphrf.org. All boats must carry applicable U.S. Coast Guard required equipment. Three boats or more will constitute a Class.
