Eligibility: All entries must have a valid 2016 PHRF of the Chesapeake rating. PHRF category 4P requirements must be met.

Rendezvous: Competitors please check in with Race Committee boat prior to warning signal. A yacht in the starting area other than at her authorized time can expect to be protested by the Race Committee.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and Annapolis Area Mark "X" or alternate mark if code flag "L" is displayed.

Course: Pass Thomas Point Light to starboard. Pass Bloody Point Light, buoy R"84" (off Poplar Island), and RN"80A" to port. Round buoy G "7" (off Black Walnut Point) to port, pass Region 3 Choptank Area Mark "D" (R"10") to starboard and round Mark "O" (Choptank River Light) to port, beware of submerged rocks around lighthouse (29.2 nautical miles).

Finish: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat (LEAVE RACE COMMITTEE BOAT TO PORT) and Choptank Area Mark "N" (R"2") off Tred Avon Yacht Club. Yachts finishing after sundown SHALL illuminate their sail numbers for at least 30 seconds at the finish line. If course is shortened, finish between orange flag on Race Committee boat and designated course rounding mark, either Bell G"7", or at Mark "O".

Time Limit: 10 hours.

Protests: Written protests must be delivered to Race Committee Chairman on Race Committee boat or representative at Club office within 1 hour of last boat finishing the race. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after completion of races.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5 & 3rd/7+ finishers plus top overall female skippered PHRF boat plus top overall junior (18 and under) skippered boat presented on Sunday after the Robson Memorial with perpetual trophies will be given at Harleigh Presentation at 1600 on Sunday 14 August 2016 (coat & tie). This is an event worth the extra time and effort to get there.

Social: Tender service provided. Cash bar, a la carte meals at club and dockside entertainment 1700-2100. Yachts may secure beside club piers at Dockmaster's discretion.

Other: Entry fee covers both Saturday and Sunday races. Fee is the same whether competing in one or all races. Yachts must submit separate entry forms for each race day. Bringing alcoholic beverages to and from the club premises is unlawful.
