Sailing Instruction "Quick Takes"

This is not an official document, but a short-cut for the experienced skipper to call out items which are not pro-forma. The Sailing Instructions are the official document governing this event. Any conflict between this document and the Sailing Instructions will not be grounds for protest, redress, nor any form of legal action. Skippers are expected to read the Sailing Instructions in full.

RULES: Running lights must be displayed from the first signal. PHRF weight limits and credits will not apply.

ENTRY: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, and One Design fleets. Deadline 1800 hrs. May 24, early entry discount through May 15.

SCHEDULE OF RACES: 1900 hrs., May 18, 25, June 1, 8, 15, 22, 29, July 6, 13, 20.

STARTING AREA: Huntington Bay, no further north than Nun "6" off Lloyd Neck.

COURSES: All marks are drop marks or Bell "8", see diagrams in Sailing Instructions.

A: W/L - 4 legs B: W/L - 5 legs C: W/L - 4 legs (Bell "8") D: W/L - 6 legs

If a division is listed on the scratch sheet as a "Short Course" class, it will sail 2 fewer legs.

Government aids to navigation, may be disregarded at the discretion of the skipper.

START: Races will be started according to RRS 26, 5 minute intervals, rolling starts.

TIME LIMIT: be 2130 hrs. for class 1, 2135 hrs. for class 2, 2140 hrs. for class 3, etc.

PENALTY SYSTEM: One-Turn outside the *Zone**, 2 turns inside the *Zone**.

PROTESTS: Notify the RC on VHF channel 72. Filing deadline: 2200 hrs. on the day following the race.

SCORING: Time-on-Time, 1 throw-out if 6 races, 2 throw-outs if 8 or more races are completed.

POST-RACE: Watch email and listen for an announcement from the RC.
