## **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1 RULES

Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes:

- 2.2 Additional classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 2000 hours on Saturday, 02 July 2016.

#### 2.3 The fee is:

- \$95 for entries received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 02 July 2016.
- \$115 for entries received after 2000 hours on Saturday, 02 July 2016, but before 2000 hours on Tuesday, 05 July 2016.
- → Deduct \$5 for each membership in CBYRA and/or USSA.
- A 50% entry fee refund will be provided if the request is received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 02 July 2016.

- 3.2 There will be a mandatory check-in requirement for all competitors prior to their start. The check-in boat location will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.
- 3.3 The starting order will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Thursday, 30 June 2016, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

#### 5 VENUE

- 5.1 The racing area will be on the Severn River and Chesapeake Bay, between the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and Cove Point.
- 5.2 A post-race breakfast and party will be held at the EYC clubhouse after the conclusion of racing.
- 5.3 An afternoon meal will be available at no additional cost to competitors, courtesy of the Annapolis Smokehouse & Tavern.

#### 6 COURSES

Competitors will sail one (1) fixed mark course that will start and finish in Annapolis, and will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 7 PRIZES

- 7.1 Prizes in each class will be as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place for three (3) or more entries;
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place for six (6) or more entries;
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place for seven (7) or more entries;
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Place for fifteen (15) or more entries;
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Place for twenty (20) or more entries.
- 7.2 Additional prizes may be awarded, at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 7.3 Beneteau America will award prizes to the top three (3) Beneteaus in the Cruising Class, and the top three (3) Beneteaus from across all Handicap Classes. At the end of the year Beneteau America will award prizes to the overall winners of the Cruising and Handicap Classes.
- 7.4 All prizes will be awarded at the post-race party, to be held at EYC on Sunday, 10 July 2016.

#### 8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the EYC Boomerang Race entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4. The organizing authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

#### 9 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

#### 10 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 10.1 This is a Clean Race. All competitors are strongly encouraged to use multi-use water bottles instead of disposable water bottles, and to recycle whenever possible. RRS 55 prohibits placing trash in the water.
- 10.2 Weather forecasting services will be provided by Weather Routing, Inc., beginning on Friday, 08 July 2016.
