Sailing Instruction "Quick Takes"

This is not an official document, but a short-cut for the experienced skipper to call out items which are not pro-forma. The Sailing Instructions are the official document governing this event. Any conflict between this document and the Sailing Instructions will not be grounds for protest, redress, nor any form of legal action. Skippers are expected to read the Sailing Instructions in full.

RULES: RRS, PHRF YRALIS, YRALIS Equipment & Safety Category C.

ENTRY: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker and One Design fleets. Deadline 1800 hrs. June 2. Early entry discount through May 29.

SCHEDULE OF RACES: Saturday, June 4, first warning signal is 11:00 hours. The Lloyd's Trophy race will begin as soon as practicable after the Huntington Day Race

STARTING AREA: Huntington Bay, vicinity of Bell "8" no further north than Nun "6" off Lloyd Neck.

COURSES: Government marks & drop marks, see Sailing Instructions for details. Spinnaker fleet will prefer windward/leeward, non-spinnaker will prefer navigator style, but either fleet may be given either style. Government marks Bell "8", Nuns "2", "4" and "6" along the north shore of Lloyd Neck must be observed when not a mark of the course.

START: Races will be started according to RRS 26, 5 minute intervals, rolling starts.

TIME LIMIT: 3 hours after the start for the first boat in division, 30 mins + time allowance from first finisher for each boat in the division. 1630 hours is the deadline for the last finisher.

PENALTY SYSTEM: One-Turn outside the Zone*, 2 turns inside the Zone*.

PROTESTS: Notify the RC on VHF channel 72. Filing deadline: 1800 hrs. June 5th.

SCORING: Time-on-Distance, separate and combined prizes.

POST-RACE: Refreshments will be served at Huntington Yacht Club on Saturday, June 4 beginning at 1700 hrs. Fee for the **BBQ is \$20 per person.**
