NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US SAILING), the rules of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club in conjunction with the North American Laser Class Association.

2 Language

The official language for this regatta will be English.

3 Inspection and Measurement

Sail inspection will be required at this regatta. Please ensure your sail numbers are applied in accordance with ILCA class rules. Sails may also be spot checked at any time during the regatta. Note that numbers and letters drawn on the sail with permanent ink pens are not legal. Refer to http://www.laserinternational.org/sailnos.htm for detailed instructions.

4 Eligibility and Entry

Laser, Radial and Laser 4.7 competitors who are members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association may enter. A minimum of five entries are required to constitute a class. If a class is not formed the registration fee will be refunded.

5 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes onshore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

7 Advance Registration

Competitors must register online at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/12640 and pay appropriate fees by the registration deadline. Registration after the deadline may be accepted at the discretion of the organizing authority and may require an additional late fee.

8 Fees

8.1 Required Fees (checks should be made payable to: Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club).

The entry fee for Laser, Radial and 4.7 entries is \$100.

Entries received after May 31st, 2016 will be considered late and a \$25 late fee will be added to the entry fee.

8.2 The entry fee includes food and water for the competitors during each race day and dinner on Saturday night. Competitors, coaches and support people must provide their own reusable water containers.

9 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available by the Thursday before the race from the Regatta Network web site.

10 Courses & Racing Area

- 10.1 Courses will be standard ILCA-NA courses as described in the ILCA-NA Regatta Guidelines.
- 10.2 The racing area is in the Los Angeles Harbor area in the vicinity of the federal breakwater, and may be either inside or outside.

11 Scoring

- 11.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4, will be used except as modified below.
- 11.2 Seven (7) races are scheduled, a minimum of three (3) races must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 11.3 When six (6) or more races are completed a sailor may discard their worst score.

12 Support/Coach/Spectator Boats

- 12.1. Support/coach/spectator boats shall register with the Race Office during the registration period. Support/coach/spectator boats shall pay a registration fee of \$50, of which \$20 will be refunded upon return of the assigned coach flag. The registration fee includes food and water for one coach/spectator during each race day and dinner on Saturday night. Competitors, coaches and support people must provide their own reusable water containers.
- 12.2. A unique registration number will be assigned to each support boat. Support, coach, spectator boats shall prominently display their assigned coach flag at all times while on the water.
- 12.3. Coaches and supporters are required to monitor the course channel on their VHF radios and be available to assist with safety when requested. Coaches are expected to attend the coaches' meeting each morning. The coaches' meeting will be held immediately after the skipper's meeting.
- 12.4. Rules governing the conduct of support/coach/spectator boats will be in the Sailing Instructions.

13 Additional Useful Information

- 13. 1 Boat launching access is available at the dry storage area or the Cabrillo Beach boat ramp.
- 13.2 Race boat storage is available in a fenced dry storage on a first come first served basis at CBYC.
- 13. 3 Parking for vehicles and storage for boats is limited. Whenever possible, participants should minimize the number of vehicles they bring to the area. Parking is available in the parking lot on 22nd Street, across from CBYC.
- 13.4 For launching larger support boats, there are two boat hoists at CBYC and a public ramp at Cabrillo Beach.
- 13.5 Guest moorage for support boats may be arranged through the marina by contacting the marina manager, Dean Wyer, at 310 519-1694 Wednesday through Sunday. The marina may group boats associated with the regatta near the dry storage.
