Registration opens July 15, 2016. Regatta entry forms and race rules can be found on the Waterford Yacht Club website, <http://www.waterfordyc.com/>. An entry fee of \$100/boat is due with the completed application. A limited number of overnight slips will be available at Waterford Harbor Marina for registered boats and will be assigned on a first-registered, first-served basis. Each entered boat will receive a goody-bag containing a Regatta t-shirt, one dinner ticket for the post-race shrimp boil, and sponsored items. Additional t-shirts and dinner tickets will be available for sale at the Skipper's Meeting and at the event. Dinner tickets are \$25 each. Raffle tickets, which include dinner, are \$50 each. Boater's Breakfast extra. The after-race activities are open to the general public, and all ticket holders may participate in the silent and live auctions. Proceeds go to support the Lighthouse Charity Team and the winning skipper's designated local charity.
