SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be made verbally to all competitors at the skippers meeting

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 3.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole on the front lawn of the main clubhouse.
- 3.2 When Flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in the race signal AP.

4 ENTRY FEE

4.1 Vanguard, Club 420, and Rhodes 19 have a \$30 entry fee, lasers 25\$

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 6.1 There will be a skippers meeting at the club at 1000 (postponed due to forecast of inclement weather in the morning). We will head out immediately after.
- 6.2 No races will be started after 1530.
- 6.3 Lunch and lunch break will be provided on the water.
- Due to a fishing tournament no boat may come back to the yacht club between 1300 and 1500, except in the case of an emergency. Please try to keep the dollies orderly when leaving the dock to not get the way.

7 FORMAT AND BASIS OF COMPETITION

7.1 The is no maximum on the number of races. We hope to get 10 races for the Vanguard 15's and 6 for the other fleets

8 RACING AREA

The racing location is in the open water of Lake Michigan within one and a half nautical miles from the Montrose Harbor entrance.

9 COURSE

9.1 The course will be windward leeward courses with a single leeward mark. There may be a separate windward mark for the V15's and the rest of the fleets.

10 MARKS

The marks of the course will be tetrahedrons.

11 THE START

- 11.1 Vanguard 15's and Lasers will use 3 minute starting sequences
- 11.2 Rhodes 19's will use 5 minute sequence
- 11.3 The start mark will be a round ball.

12 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

Marks may be moved as necessary to maintain the course configuration or to change the course length, but no mark will be moved when any boat is on the leg that it terminates.

13 THE FINISH

The finish will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the start boat and the course side of an orange ball at the starboard end.

14 PRIZES

Awards will be given to the top team.
