Skipper's Meeting: 10:00 AM, Block Island Club clubhouse, Corn Neck Road, Block Island, (accessible by dingy or launch in the Northeast corner of the Great Salt Pond)

First Gun: 13:00

Start/Finish: Outside the entrance channel of the Great Salt Pond

Classes: To be determined by the Race Committee. There will likely be at least two classes, one spinnaker and one non-spinnaker class. PHRF scoring will be used.

Course: Weather permitting, a 12 mile around-the-buoys on Block Island Sound. Start/Finish line outside the New Harbor entrance channel. Sailing instructions will be available on line at the Event web site: www.regattanetwork.com/event/13130 and at the skippers' meeting.

Awards: Perpetual Harold Madison Trophy for best overall corrected time and trophies for top three finishers in each class.

Awards Party: To follow the race on the grounds of the Block Island Club.

- Moorings, Docks, etc.: Marinas, Town moorings and public anchorage are all in the Great Salt Pond. Due to its size and location, the Block Island Club cannot offer overnight docking or moorings. There is a dinghy dock available for the skippers' meeting and post-race party.
- Fees: Online preregistration: \$35 per boat; \$40 at skippers meeting on day of race. All proceeds will be donated to the Mary D Fund.
