

2016 FALL SCORE / DOUBLE HANDED SERIES

August 28, September 25 and October 23 of 2016

1 Rules

- 1.2 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.3 Rule 40 will be changed to require competitors to wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- Rules 41 and 62.1(a) will be modified to allow the Race Committee at their discretion to hail boats at the start who are On Course Side (OCS) via Channel 68 and this will not be considered outside assistance.
- 1.5 Rule 41 will be changed to replace the Two-Turn penalty with a One-Turn Penalty
- 1.6 Rule 55 will be changed in the sailing instructions by adding the following sentence to the rule: 'However, discarding biodegradable sail stops when setting a sail will not be considered a breach of rule 55.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.2 This series is open to any boat holding a valid 2015 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate.
- 2.3 There will be a Double Handed division, and the following PHRF divisions: A fleet (80 or less), B Fleet (greater than 81), Jib & Main (181 or less) and Jib & Main (greater than 181). Double Handed division shall have exactly two persons on board. PHRF divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form for the event listed at http://regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.php or from the event information link found at http://scyc.org/racing.
- 2.5 Only on-line entries will be accepted.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The regular entry fee is \$90 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on Saturday August 20, 2016.
- 3.2 A late entry fee of \$110.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Saturday, August 20, 2016.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1100 hours on Sunday, October 23, 2016.
- 3.4 All entry fees are nonrefundable.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors' meeting is scheduled for **1010 hours on Saturday**, **August 27, 2016** at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours on August 28, and 1225 hours on other race days.
- Five races are scheduled for the series. On August 28 a race will start in an area off Moss Landing and finish in Santa Cruz. On September 25 and October 23 there will be two races each day starting and finishing in an area off Santa Cruz.
- 4.3 Three (3) races will constitute a series.
- 4.5 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse for daily prizes each race day immediately after racing, and a final awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse following racing on October 23.

5 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and online. Courses will be distributed with the sailing instructions.

6 Venues

Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in the area bounded by Moss Landing to the southeast, Davenport to the northwest and extending up to ten miles off shore.

7 Prizes

7.1 Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority. Boats entered in divisions with three (3) or more entries in the series are eligible for the Champion of Champions Regatta.
