7. DEFINITION OF JUNIOR

7.1 Junior classes are defined in the 2016 SAYRA Junior Championship Series Notice of Race.

8. COURSES

8.1 Course will be as described in the Sailing Instructions available at the CSC Clubhouse Friday evening and Saturday morning.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 One race shall constitute a regatta.
- 9.2 The low point scoring system, Appendix A of the RRS will apply, except that each yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. (No throw outs.)
- 9.3 Need 5 boats to make a class.

10. PRIZES

10.1 The number of trophies will be approximately one for every four entries.
