NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

All races will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Sea Dog Deed of Gift and any adjustments and/or changes thereto.

JAM sail limitations and equipment restrictions for JAM participants are governed by PHRF-LE rules for non-spinnaker fleets.

Rules restricting the use of VHF radio, Loran and/or GPS are waived for all classes.

JAM, T-10 and PHRF class rules are changed to require that each boat shall race with not less than three persons.

US Sailing prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2, and 63.4 will not apply.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

This event is restricted to mono-hulls only.

All entrants must be a member of the Edgewater Yacht Club race program and must race with the boat owner or a family member of legal age as owner's representative on board.

All entrants who compete for the "Seadog Trophy" must be a current member of one of the three Edgewater Yacht Club Cruising Fleets (PHRF, JAM, T-10) by September 1, 2016, be properly registered, in compliance with the Rules of PHRF-LE, and hold a valid PHRF-LE certificate (or its assigned equivalent.).

Boats properly registered, but not meeting the eligibility requirements for the "Seadog Trophy" will be scored for the "Van Newberry Trophy."

The Seadog-Van Newberry Trophy Race Committee, at its sole discretion, whose decision is final and without appeal, shall determine eligibility and placement in fleet, class and division.

MEASUREMENT

A boat and/or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with Class Rules, the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race. Except for on-line, entrants shall submit a copy of their valid 2016 PHRF-LE rating certificate by the registration deadline. Boats without a current PHRF-LE measurement certificate may be assigned a temporary rating at the discretion of the Race Committee which shall be valid for this race only and cannot be appealed.

REGISTRATION

Boats may register on-line at https:// EWYC Regatta Network website, or in person at Edgewater Yacht Club by completing the designated Seadog-Van Newberry registration form, and, paying the required entry fee.

FEES

Required fees for the Seadog-Van Newberry Trophy race are \$15.00 and must be paid in full prior to the close of registration.

SKIPPERS MEETING

All skippers, or their designated representative, are required to attend the Skippers Meeting at 10:00am the morning of the race at the EWYC clubhouse.

RACING AREA AND COURSE

All racing shall take place on Lake Erie, north of Edgewater Yacht Club. The specific course to be sailed, sailing instructions, division splits and starting order will be available at the mandatory Skippers Meeting 10:00 am, October 2nd, 2016.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A2, will apply.

PRIZES

First, Second and Third place prizes will be awarded for each class. The Seadog Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the eligible boat scored as First Overall. The Van Newberry Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the eligible boat scored First Overall.
