1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta is sanctioned event the Gulf Yachting Association and will be sailed under the management of the Gulfport, Biloxi, & Long Beach Yacht Clubs.
- 1.2. This regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the GYA Regulations for sanctioned events (available at www.gya.org)

2. CLASSES & ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1 Classes to be sailed: PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF NON-Spinnaker, Melges 24, VX One Design, and the Viper 640.
- 2.2 All entrants must complete the registration form on line at GulfportYachtClub.org or the Regatta Page http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/13870
- 2.3 For the PHRF Classes, all yachts must have a current GYA PHRF Rating Certificate. The PHRF Classes Crew limits (number or weight) as reflected on the boat's valid GYA PHRF certificate will be in effect. For GYA Rating information please go to www.GYA-PHRF.com

3. ENTRIES & FEES

- 3.1 All entries in the GORC (PHRF Classes) must check-in with their completed Crew Lists at the registration desk at Gulfport Club by 1830 hours April 6th, 2017. Fees: \$45 before April 1, 2017, \$65 after.
- 3.2 All entries in the Sportboat Championship (Melges 24, VX One, Viper 640 Classes) must check-in with their completed Crew Lists at the registration desk at Gulfport Yacht Club by 1030 hours April 7th, 2017. *Fees:* \$75 before April 1, 2017, \$95 after.

4. SAFETY:

- 4.1 All boats shall comply with United States Coast Guard safety equipment regulations.
- 4.2 Boats competing in the GORC (PHRF Classes) shall comply with the US Sailing Special Equipment Requirements for Nearshore Racing, check-In with Race Committee at the beginning of each day of racing with all of the crew wearing their PFD's, carry a working motor with enough fuel to motor 20 miles, and have proper working navigation lights.
- 4.4 Boats competing in the Sportboat Championship (Melges 24, VX One, Viper 640 Classes) must wear their PFD while away from the dock and while racing.

4.4 A boat shall report for any safety inspection when asked to do so by the Race Committee or Protest Committee. Any boat found without all safety items may incur a scoring penalty or disqualified by the Protest Committee.

5. CHANGES TO RACING RULES:

The Sailing Instructions may change some of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
