Race Committee boat. The Race Committee may shorten the course.

Finish: Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and last mark of course.

Time Limit: Midnight for all classes. Boats not finishing within one hour of the first boat in their class

to finish will be scored TLE and awarded points equal to the number of finishers plus two,

but in no case more than the number of starters. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

Scoring: Yachts in classes having few entries may be combined to ensure all yachts will be

competing for at least one award. Final ratings used for yachts in handicap classes
