Notice of Race

For Handicap Fleets to be held at Marina del Rey Sunday, February 26, 2017

1 RULES

This Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2017-2020.*

2 ELIIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to current (2017) members of PHRF and Cruising classes.
- 2.2 Each entrant must belong to a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, racing a boat which is registered in the class or fleet in which it competes.
- 2.3 Entrants in the Cruising class must <u>first</u> complete the MYC Cruiser Handicap Credit Worksheet ("Cruiser Worksheet") by downloading and printing it from Regatta Network. After doing so, Cruising class entrants should enter on Regatta Network using their <u>adjusted cruiser rating</u> (PHRF Area B RLC rating +/- cruiser handicap credits claimed). The Race Committee reserves the right to correct any cruiser handicap credit(s) claimed which is not appropriate to a given boat.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter on-line at Regatta Network until Thursday February 23rd no later than 1800 hrs. Cruising class entrants must also e-mail their completed Cruiser Worksheet to the PRO (e-mail address below) no later than the above date and time. Late entries accepted only with the permission of the PRO.
- 2.5 Alternately, eligible boats may enter by mailing the attached MYC/SBYRC Entry Form, along with the completed Cruiser Worksheet, if applicable, to the address listed on that Entry Form so that such documents are <u>received</u> no later than February 23, 2017 (post-mark by that date is insufficient).

3 CLASSES

Classes will be established for PHRF and Cruising fleets, with a minimum of three entries, based on entries received by 1800 hours on February 23, 2017.

4 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 One random leg race is scheduled for all classes.
- 4.2 The warning signal for the first start is scheduled to be 1155 hrs.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on Regatta Network by 1800 hrs. on Thursday February 23, 2017.

6 COURSES

Courses for each class will be chosen from one of the special courses set forth in the Sailing Instructions.

PENALTIES

The two turns penalty is modified to one turn including one tack and one gybe. This changes *RRS* 44.2.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 No race score will be excluded.
- 8.2 PHRF classes will use their Area B RLC ratings.
- 8.3 The Cruising class will use ratings based on the MYC Cruiser Worksheet .

9 PRIZES

The Dr. Robert Baker Perpetual Trophy will be awarded jointly to the PHRF boat in the largest PHRF class and to the cruising class boat in the largest cruising class with the best overall performances.

Take home trophies will be given as follows:

3-4 boats - 1 trophy 5-6 boats - 2 trophies 11+ boats - 4 trophies

Hospitality and trophy ceremony after the race will be in the Monterrey Room in the **East Tower** of the **Marina City Club**, 4333 Admiralty Way, MDR, CA 90292
