- **10.4** When five (5) or more races are completed, a boats series will be the total of the scores excluding its worst excludable score.
- **10.5** Scores will be computed for both Foiling and Classic Divisions, as well as overall.

11. Rules for Fleet Division

11.1 All registered boats will be divided into Foilers or Classic fleets.

- 11.2 All sailors will designate the specific fleet for racing at final registration when their registration form is signed at site.
 - 11.3 Once registered no changes between fleets will be allowed.
 - **11.4** All boats will have one start.

12.Berthing

Boats shall be kept on the grounds of Sandy Hook Bay Catamaran Club.

13. Radio Communications

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while race nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
