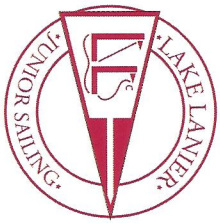

Weekend Junior Training

Spring and Fall training sessions are scheduled several times a month on the weekends. This is primarily designed for beginner and intermediate sailors that want extra practice or skill building. Sessions typically last no more than 3 hrs per group. Instruction is provided by US Sailing Level 1 instructors. Juniors must have completed a basic sailing class that includes a swim check, capsize drill and basic rigging prior to attending.

LLSC Regattas

LLSC offers several opportunities for junior sailors to race. These include junior courses combined with larger regattas such as Reggae Regatta, Halloween Regatta, Jr. Commodore's Cup and 4th of July. Juniors are encouraged to participate in as many sailing opportunities as they can. Sportsmanship is *strongly reinforced* in all events.

Junior Family Fun Activities

LLSC offers several junior focused functions that center around sailing at the club. These include: Beach party days (Memorial Day & 4th of July), beach picnics, cruising events, trick or treating on a hay ride, Christmas party and many more. LLSC has a strong social event schedule that is family friendly.

Junior Race Team

LLSC Jr. Racing Team is a prestigious team where the intermediate and advanced sailors qualify for the team. Team shirts are awarded once qualifications met. Application form is available from the director.

Club Owned Optimist and C420 Boats

LL Jr. Sailing Program has 10 C420s used for member check out, training and team racing. Check out is required for member use. 3 club owned Optimist are designed for ENTRY level trainer boats. These boats may be used for training days and chartered for camp weeks. These boats are designed for new members and sailors looking to try it out prior to purchasing own boat.

Adult Sailing Program

Training opportunities for adults are offered with several classes: Adult Sailing 101, Women's Sailing and entry level racing. More information on www.llsc.com.

Lake Lanier Jr. Sailing Program is a 501(c)3 program. We accept donations to help support the equipment needs of our junior sailors!



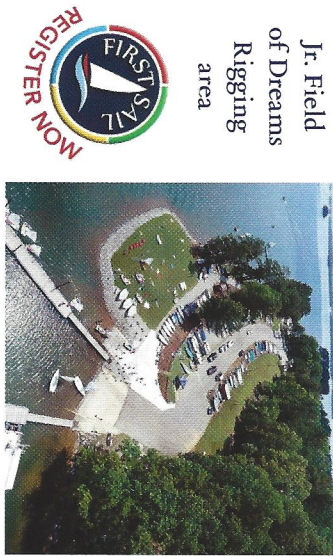

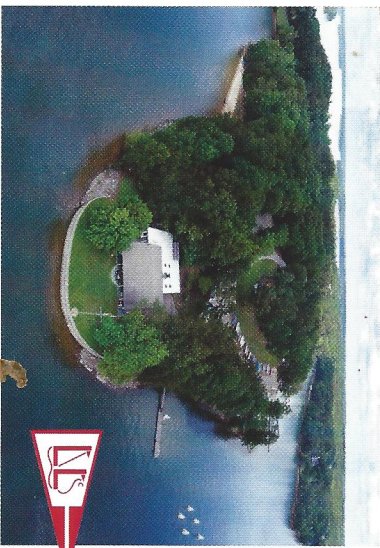

Junior Day Camp #1 May 30-June 2 8:30 - 5:00 pm 4 days Tuesday - Friday

This camp is offered at LLSC to encourage beginners, intermediates and advanced sailors to get their sailing season started with a 4 day camp that focuses on fun, boating safety and the basics of sailing. Intermediate and advanced sailors will be separated and focus on technical skills and racing.

Group #1 - Optimist Sailboats ages 7-14

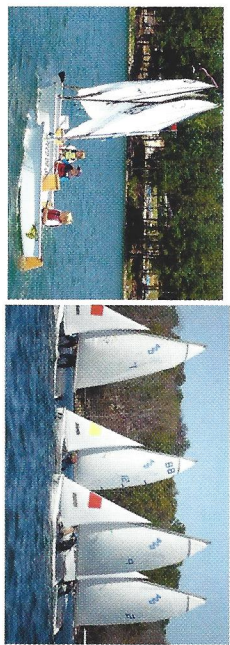
Bring your own boat (boats for charter)
Camp fees: \$250 member / \$300 non member
Space limited to 20

Group #2 - C420 Sailboat ages 11 to 17 and 110 lbs (Boats provided)

Camp fees: \$300 member / \$350 non member
Space limited to 20

Other Camp Information:

- Campers provide own lunch, snack is provided in afternoon.
- Class runs from 9am - 4pm
- Water bottle, lifejacket, Sunscreen, water shoes (closed toe), towel & change of clothes required.
- All campers must pass a 'swim check' with a lifejacket and be able to tread water.
- Friday conclusion for fun awards, 3pm. See-n-sail photo opportunity at 2 pm.
- Late Fee for registration after May 15th \$100
- Member registration starts 3/15, Non-Member 4/1.



Junior Week Camp #2 June 4-9 8am till 7pm 5.5 days *3 pm start on Sunday

This camp is offered at LLSC to encourage beginners, intermediates and advanced sailors to get sailing training that focuses on fun, boating safety and the basics of sailing including racing. Intermediate and advanced sailors will be separated and focus on technical skills and racing. The end of the week will conclude with racing for all levels and a family style dinner and awards Friday night. Total # of campers limited to 55.

Group #2 - C420 Sailboat ages 11-17 & 110 lbs

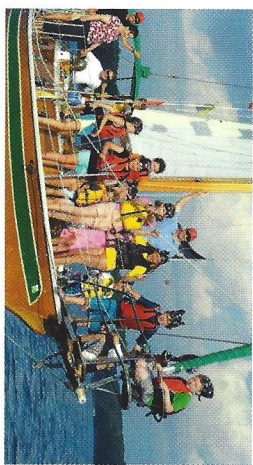
Camp fees: \$400 member / \$500 non member
Space limited to 20 (Boats provided)

Group #3 - Laser 4.7/Radial/Full Sailboat ages 12-17 & 110 lbs Bring your own boat

Camp fees: \$350 member / \$450 non member

Other Camp Information:

- Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner provided for all campers.
- Additional weekly parent/sibling meal packages available for \$75 adults / \$35 for under 10 (16 meals total / 5.5 days)
- Instructional class runs from 9am - 4:30pm
- All sailors must be checked in between 8-9AM and out by 7PM by a parent/guardian.
- Camping on club camp grounds encouraged with parents.
- Parent volunteers required: 1 day of parent volunteer service (or 2 1/2 days) per child registered. If not able to serve \$150 fee applies.
- Rigging certification = Opis and Lasers much check boats in Sunday to confirm all parts present.
- Water bottle, lifejacket, Sunscreen, water shoes (closed toe), towel & change of clothes required.
- All campers must pass a 'swim check' with a lifejacket and be able to tread water. This will occur on Sunday afternoon from 3:30-4:30pm.
- Friday See-n-sail photo opportunity at 2pm. Friday dinner 5pm, camp awards following.
- Late Fee for registration after May 1st \$100
- Member registration starts 3/15, Non-Member 4/1.

Junior Adventure Camp #3 June 12-16 8:30 - 5:00 pm 5 days Monday - Friday

This camp is offered at LLSC to encourage all sailors to enjoy the lake and experience many different types of boats LLSC has to offer. The focus will be safe and fun on the water while sailing to destinations (ie: Aqualand for ice cream, islands for lunch, etc.) using many boats (ie: Stand Up Paddleboards, Kayaks, Optimist, C420s, Flying Scots, and rides on keel boats). The goal is to be safe on the water while enjoying the sport of sailing. Juniors will be grouped by ages in different types of boats.
