1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Optimist, Laser Radial and Club 420 classes.
2.2 The regatta is open to all Junior sailors. Competitors shall not have reached their 19th birthday by December 31, 2017.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be posted on the Official Notice Board located on the patio window of the clubhouse.

Support boats shall complete registration. Coaches from CBYRA member clubs shall display coach flag. Coaches shall wear PFDs.

10 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to top three boats in each class.

Charter Boats HYC owned 420s and Optimists may be available for charter. Charter fee \$50 with sails provided, \$35 without sails. Reserve in advance.

Support Boat Launching Boats under 2000 lbs with lifting rigs may hoist launch at HYC. Boats needing a ramp for trailer launching should launch at Sunset Boat Ramp on Sunset Creek. Public ramp, no fee, parking available for cars and trailers. From HYC take Victoria Blvd, turn left on Kecoughtan Road, turn left on Ivy Home Road, and left on Marina Road.

Accommodations Crowne Plaza Hampton- Marina within walking distance. Many more hotels in every price range at Coliseum Central. Limited housing available for out of town competitors in members' homes.

Food Complimentary continental breakfast. Entry fee includes bag lunch for competitors.. Competitors should bring their own reusable water bottles. Other meals available for purchase by parents and coaches.

Tow to Norfolk afterwards Safety boats will be available after sailing to tow 420's and Radials from the course area to Norfolk Yacht and Country Club for the Friday regatta (VA Commonwealth Regatta). Optimists should return to HYC, derig, and trailer to NY&CC. Radial and 420 awards will be presented in Norfolk. We will be looking for parents who are able to put 420 and Radial dollies into their vehicles and bring them over to NYCC for sailors' arrival.
