2017 MOORE 24 Pacific Coast Championship





1 Rule

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors to wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will alter RRS 44.1 replacing a two-turns penalty with a one-turn penalty.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Boats of the Moore 24 class are eligible to participate in this regatta.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at

https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/14386. Only on-line entries will be accepted.

3 Fees

3.1 The regular non-refundable entry fee is \$125.00 and is applicable if entry is completed by 20:00 hours on Wednesday, May 3, 2017.

- 3.2 The entry fee is \$150.00 for all entries received after 20:00 hours on Wednesday, May 3, 2017.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 10:00 hours on Saturday, May 6, 2017.

4 Schedules

4.1 A competitors briefing is scheduled for 10:30 hours on Saturday, May 6, 2017 at the SCYC clubhouse.

- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 12:30 hours Saturday and 12:00 hours Sunday.
- 4.3 Six races (6) are scheduled. Three races on Saturday and three races on Sunday.
- 4.4 Three (3) races will constitute a regatta.
- 4.5 No warning signal will be made after 15:30 hours on Sunday May 7, 2017.

4.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse on Sunday May 7, 2017 following racing.

6 Venue

6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys and fixed buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 3.5 mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

<u>Trailer Parking:</u> Trailers cannot be parked in regular parking spaces. See enclosed parking map.
