Region 2, Chesapeake Bay Area Standard Racing Marks. A course for the slower fleets will be posted first, **BREAK** – then longer course posted for remaining classes. The RC plans to offer two courses depending on wind speed and direction. Course notice will be provided 24 hours prior to event start or earlier if possible, via email to all registrants.
