Notice of Race

Del Rey Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority.

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2. Class Rule protests shall be filed prior to the first race of the regatta unless it is alleged that alterations to a boat are made after acceptance of the Measurement Checklist by the regatta registration committee.

1.3. Electronic tactical compasses (for example TackTic compasses) can only be used in "compass mode" and shall not use any "multiple data sources" from the device.

1.4. The registered skipper and crew team shall sail the entire regatta together, unless an emergency arises and the crew cannot continue. In this case, the Organizing Authority must approve the use of a replacement crew. If a replacement crew is approved that crew shall sail the remainder of the regatta.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1. Advertising is restricted per ISAF Regulation 20.2.1 and Table 1 to Event Advertising only.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The Women's regatta is open to all women and the Junior Regatta is open to all juniors under the age of 18 sailing on race day in an eligible Lido 14 as noted in the Lido 14 Class By-Laws. Class membership not required but the boat sailed must be registered to a class member. This changes class by laws Article XV 1(a) (2) The Registered Skipper shall be a member of the Association.
3.2. To enter, go to dryc.org and click on the Lido 14 Championship link.

4. FEES

4.1. The entry fee shall be \$25 **4.2.** NO entries will be accepted after 9:00AM on August 5, 2017, Women's and 9:00 AM on August 6, 2017, Juniors.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1. Saturday, August 5, Women's, Registration and Crew Weigh-in 0830 - 1000 DRYC patio Skipper' Meeting 1030, DRYC patio Racing – 1225, Warning Signal Post racing, BBQ and award ceremony DRYC aft deck **5.2. Sunday August, 6, Junior's** Registration and Crew Weigh-in 0830 - 1000 DRYC patio Skipper' Meeting 1030, DRYC patio Racing – 1225 Warning Signal Post - Race BBQ and award ceremony DRYC aft deck **5.3.** Five (5) or more races are scheduled for both the Women's and Junior's

6. ON-SITE REGISTRATION, MEASUREMENT AND WEIGH-IN'S

6.1. Weigh-in requirements are to be completed by each competitor as follows:

a) Crew weight is to be determined in normal sailing attire at Registration (See schedule for Registration times)

b) Each boat is to have a valid measurement certificate completed prior to final registration for the event. **6.2.** Each boat shall carry its required ballast during racing (as required for hull and crew weight). The Registration Committee will post each boat's required corrector weight amount on the Official Notice Board prior to the start of racing. The top 3 finishers in every race may be subject to having their required adjuster weight checked at the dock. If so notified, the required competitors shall stay on the dock until cleared by the race committee.

6.3. The Organizing Authority may measure or inspect any boat and/or her equipment and sails before or after any race(s), for compliance to class rules.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than the start of registration, and if possible, posted on www.dryc.org (Click on the link to the Championship regatta)

8. VENUE

8.1. Races will be held in the waters in the area of the Marina Del Rey harbor.

9. COURSES

9.1. The courses shall be windward-leeward legs.

10. SCORING

10.1. Appendix A Low Point Scoring System will apply, with the following modification, No throughout. One completed race is required to constitute a series.

11. SUPPORT/COACH/SPECTATOR BOATS

11.1. Support/coach/spectator boats shall register with the Regatta Chairperson(s) the day of the regatta.

11.2. Rules governing the conduct of support/coach/spectator boats will be in the Sailing Instructions.

12. PRIZES

12.1 Prizes will be awarded in the follow categories as described in the bylaws:

Top 3 winners of the Women's Top 3 winners of the Junior's

12.2 Perpetual trophies will be awarded as provided by the Lido 14 Class Association

12.3 Trophies will be awarded after racing in the patio @DRYC.
