

Sailing Instructions

GSBYRA Jr. Race Week

July 26-28

Bellport Bay YC, Moriches YC, Westhampton YS

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Entries

Competitors may enter by completing the online form at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/14585. Registration must be completed by the morning of the event.

3. Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in each yacht club.

4. Signals Made Ashore

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 20 minutes after flag AP is lowered.

5. Schedule

A competitors' meeting will be held each day of the event at 10:00 AM. Changes to the Sailing Instructions may be made at the competitor's meeting. The warning signals for the first race will be at 10:30 AM. Subsequent races each day will be held as soon as practicable after the end of the previous race, with 6 races scheduled each day. The 420 class may may compete for a separate distance race from Moriches YC to Westhampton YS at the end of racing on Thursday. This distance race will not count in the series score.

6. Racing Area

The racing area will be Bellport Bay on Wednesday and and Moriches Bay on Thursday and Friday.

7. Starting and Finishing Lines

The starting and finishing lines will be between the Race Committee Boat and a pin buoy. Three minute dinghy starts will be used. The start/finish line is not an obstruction.

8. Time Limit

The time limit for each race will be one hour for the first boat to finish.

9. Protests

Protests shall be delivered to the yacht club(s) within 20 minutes after the race committee finish boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing each day.


10. Scoring


Eighteen races are scheduled. For every 6 races completed per day, each boat's worst score will be excluded from her daily score.

11. Courses and Marks

The courses will be WL, W4, OT, and Port Triangle. The course will be designated on a whiteboard on the Race Committee. All marks will be orange or yellow buoys. The attached diagram shows the courses, course designations, the marks in order and the rounding direction of each mark.
