Notice of Race Amendment #1

1. RULES -- is amended to add the following:

1.5 RSS Rule 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

8. SCORING -- is changed as shown

- 8.3 RRS A9 (Series Longer than a Regatta) shall apply but is modified as follows:
 - a. Boats that do not register before the Series begins will receive a score of three (3) points more than the number of <u>finishers</u> in each race prior to their registering for the Series. This modifies *RRS* A4.2 and *RRS* A9.
 - b. A registered boat that did not check in for that day's racing (scored DNC) shall be scored points for the finishing place two (2) more than the number of <u>finishers</u> in the race. This modifies *RRS* A4.2 and *RRS* A9.
 - c. A registered boat that did check-in, but did not start (scored DNS) or, did not finish (scored DNF), or is disqualified (scored DSQ or DNE), or retires (scored RET); shall be scored points for the finishing place one (1) more than the number of <u>finishers</u> in the race. This modifies *RRS* A4.2 and *RRS* A9.

Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the fleet in which a boat is racing shall apply (e.g. PHRF So Cal).
- 1.2 Neither symmetrical nor asymmetrical spinnakers (as defined by PHRF So Cal) are to be used.
- 1.3 Boats SHALL NOT enter the mooring areas or the anchorage areas. Mooring areas and anchorage areas are defined as obstructions.
- 1.4 Two headsails (as defined by PHRF So Cal) are allowed.

2. CLASSES

- 2.1 Boats less than 50 feet LOA are invited to race.
- 2.2 Class Breaks will be addressed in the Sailing Instructions.

3. SCHEDULE

The first warning signal is scheduled for 1800 hours each race date.

4. ENTRIES and FEES

- 4.1 Entries will be accepted until noon on race day.
- 4.2 The entry fee for the Series is \$55 with a \$2 discount for providing your current US Sailing membership number at registration.
- 4.3 Any PHRF So Cal member's boat that has its rating changed after having submitted an Entry shall provide BCYC with its new Rating prior to noon on race day with an election to race in its original class at its new rating or in a new class assigned by the Race Committee with all prior Taco Tuesday Series races scored DNC.

5. ENTRY FORM

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 1700 hrs the day before the first race at the BCYC Official Notice Board or on the web at RegattaNetwork.com in the calendar under May 16th or by web searching for "BCYC Taco Tuesday Handicapped Random Leg Harbor Racing".

7. COURSES

- 7.1 Start and Finish Lines will be in the Newport Harbor Five-Points area.
- 7.2 Random Leg Courses will be displayed from the Committee Boat.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 Daily prize scoring for each Class (A, B...) will have no throw-outs. This changes RRS A2.
- 8.2 Series prize scoring for each Class shall include all Series races and 1 throw-out for every 5 races run. This changes RRS A2.
- 8.3 RRS A9 (Series Longer than a Regatta) shall apply.

9. PRIZES

- 9.1 Daily Take-Home prizes in each Class will be awarded after each race.
- 9.2 A Series Take Home prize for each Class will be awarded after the last day of racing.
- 9.3 A Series Perpetual Trophy winner will be named for each Class after the last day of racing.
