# Notice of Race

#### 1. Rules

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

# 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This event is open to the Hobie 20, Hobie 18, Hobie 17, Hobie 16, Hobie Wave, Formula 18 Class, A Class Catamaran classes and Weta Class Multihulls.
- 2.2. At the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority, other Multihull one design classes under 21 feet may petition to participate if a minimum of three (3) boats are registered by the end of the normal registration period.
- 2.3. One competitor on each Hobie Class boat must be a member of the Hobie Class Association of North America.
- 2.4. All boats must comply with their class rules at all times during the regatta.
- 2.5. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.scyc.org/racing (http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/14802.)

### 3. Fees

- 3.1. Registration entry fee is \$75 for double-handed boats and \$65 for single-handed boats if received before or on July 18, 2017. Youth skippers under 18 deduct \$10 from the entry fee if received before or on July 18, 2017.
- 3.2. The Late entry fee is \$100 for double-handed boats and \$90 for single-handed boats for entries after July 18, 2017.
- 3.3. Notice of Parking and Launching providing instructions regarding Launching, Trailer and boat parking, Vehicles and passes (Notice of Parking and Launching) will be posted on the event website at www.scyc.org/racing (http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/14802.) Competitors and guests will need to purchase parking and trailer passes to park and launch at Santa Cruz Harbor. Vehicles and Trailers not displaying a pass or not parked in the designated areas may be ticketed by the Santa Cruz Harbormaster.

# 4. Schedule

- 4.1. Competitor briefing is scheduled for July 22, 2017 at 1100 hours near the boat park at the hoist
- 4.2. The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day.
- 4.3. No races will be started after 1600 hours Sunday July 23, 2017
- 4.4. Up to nine (9) races are scheduled in the Regatta.
- 4.5. Three (3) races constitute a regatta
- 4.6. On Saturday July 22, 2017 after racing, there will be a social at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club Clubhouse. Hobie Fleet 240 will host a bring your own food to cook on the BBQ on the SCYC lower deck – pot luck style.
- 4.7. There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse on Sunday, July 23, 2017 following racing.

# 5. Sailing Instructions

#### 6. Venue

6.1. Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

#### 7. Prizes

7.1. The number of prizes to be awarded will be at the discretion of the organizing authority and based on the number of normal registered competitors.
