1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Any sailing Instructions on the mark charts DO NOT APPLY, and only the Corinthian Cup Sailing Instructions apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Club membership is urged but not required. A current PHRF or Corinthian certificate is required for all classes.
- 2.2 Cruisers will be rated using their PHRF Corinthian Rating for 2017.
- 2.3 Entries should preferably be filled out using online registration at <u>www.regattanetwork.com</u> and will end at 0900 on Saturday, May 27. Please note that registration is not complete until fees are paid.

3. FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$45 for the two-day, two-leg series, or \$30 for one leg.
- 3.2 Dinner is \$16 paid separately to RBYC. Please RSVP with RBYC Commodore, Ski Tarnosky: <u>e.tarnosky@gmail.com</u> by noon, Thursday May 25 for Saturday's dinner with your selection of chicken or steak.

4. CLASSES / CLASS FLAGS

- 4.1 There will be three classes.
- 4.2 The Race Committee reserves the option to assign entries to classes for competitive balance.
- 4.3 Class flags will be assigned in the Sailing Instructions.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at <u>www.regattanetwork.com</u> and both <u>SCCYC</u>, <u>RBYC</u> web sites no later than 2000 hours on Friday, May 26, the day prior to the race.

7. COURSE / STARTING AREA

- 7.1 Saturday, Leg One's course will be from Marina del Rey to King Harbor, using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay.
- 7.2 Leg One, the start will be outside of the Marina del Rey breakwater.
- 7.3 Sunday, Leg Two's course will be from King Harbor to Marina del Rey, using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay.
- 7.4 Leg Two, the start will be in the ocean outside of the harbor entrance.

8. SERIES SCORING

There are two legs to the race, one leg each day. The corrected elapsed times will be used for scoring.

9. TROPHIES

Individual trophies for the series will be awarded at SCCYC after racing on Sunday. A name plate for the winner of each class will be added to the perpetual trophy.

Dock space is usually not assigned until the day before and sometimes not until you arrive in Redondo Beach. Please give Ski as much lead time as possible. Boats assigned a slip will be asked for a \$20 deposit for a dock/head key upon arrival. The deposit will be refunded upon return of the key. Keys should be returned on Sunday morning to RBYC.
