Notice of Race

- 1. RULES
 - 1.1 The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the fleet in which a boat is racing shall apply (e.g. PHRF of Southern California).
 - 1.2 The Marine Industry Racer (MIR) rule of PHRF of Southern California does not apply to this regatta.
 - 1.3 RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, are required.
 - 1.4 US Sailing Prescriptions 63.2, and 62.4 are deleted.
 - 1.5 The Regatta is classified as a Category "A" Event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
 - 1.6 *RRS* 55 is changed by adding the following sentence to the rule: "However, discarding elastic or wool bands when setting a sail is permitted."

2. CLASSES

2.1 Class Breaks will be addressed in the Sailing Instructions.

3. SCHEDULE

- 3.1 The races are scheduled to be sailed on June 10, July 22, and August 12, 2017
- 3.2 Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 hours on the day before the race on the Race Bulletin Board at BCYC and on-line at www.RegattaNetwork.com.
- 3.3 The first warning signal is scheduled for 1155 hours.

4. ENTRIES and FEES

- 4.1 Entries will be accepted until 0800 hours on race day.
- 4.2 The entry fee for the Series is \$38.00 with a \$2.00 discount when registering with your 2017 US Sailing membership number.
- 4.3 Each entrant must be a member of PHRF of Southern California and have a valid rating certificate, and must be a member of an SCYA Member Yacht Club or a USSA recognized yacht club if not a resident of Area J.
- 4.4 Any PHRF So Cal member's boat that has its rating changed after having submitted an Entry shall provide BCYC with its new Rating prior to noon on race day with a decision as to if it wishes to race in its original class with its new rating or in a new class assigned by the Race Committee with all prior series races scored DNC.

5. ENTRY FORM

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 1700 hrs the day before the first race at the BCYC Official Notice Board or on the web at RegattaNetwork.com in the calendar under June 10th or by web searching for "BCYC ocean PHRF Angelman Series" at www.regattanetwork.com or at the online Notice Board at

7. COURSES

- 7.1 Start and Finish Lines will be off the Newport Pier.
- 7.2 Courses will be indicated from the Committee Boat.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 There are no throwouts. This changes *RRS* A2.
- 8.2 RRS A9 (Series Longer than a Regatta) shall apply but is modified as follows:
 - a. Boats that do not register before the Series begins will receive a score of three (3) points more than the number of <u>finishers</u> in each race prior to their registering for the Series. This modifies *RRS* A4.2 and *RRS* A9.
 - b. A registered boat that did not check in for that day's racing (scored DNC) shall be scored points for the finishing place two (2) more than the number of <u>finishers</u> in the race. This modifies *RRS* A4.2 and *RRS* A9.
 - c. A registered boat that did check-in, but did not start (scored DNS) or was judged On Course Side (OCS) or did not finish (scored DNF) or is disqualified (scored DSQ or DNE), or retires (scored RET), shall be scored points for the finishing place one (1) more than the number of <u>finishers</u> in the race. This modifies *RRS* A4.2 and *RRS* A9.

9. PRIZES

- 9.1 Daily Take-Home prizes for each class will be awarded after each race.
- 9.2 Series Take Home prizes for each class will be awarded after the last day of racing.
- 9.3 Series Perpetual Trophy(s), will be awarded after the last day of racing.

10. DISCLAIMER

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
