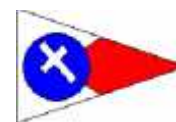

Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The series is open to any boat holding a valid Monterey Bay PHRF certificate.
- 2.2. There will be the following PHRF divisions: A Fleet (80 or less), B Fleet (greater than 80), Double Handed, Jib & Main (181 or less) and Jib & Main (greater than 181).
- 2.3. Double Handed division shall have exactly two persons on board.
- 2.4. Other divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board.
- 2.5. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form for the event listed at:

3. Fees

- 3.1. The regular entry fee is \$90.00 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on Aug 20, 2017.
- 3.2. The late entry fee is \$110.00 and is applicable to all entries received after the above time.
- 3.3. Registration closes at 1100 hours on Oct 22, 2017.

4. Schedules

- 4.1. A Regatta Briefing will be held at 1000 hours on Saturday, Aug 26, 2017 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2. Scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours on Aug 27 and 1225 hours on other race days.
- 4.3. Five races are scheduled; one on Aug 27 and two on other race days.
- 4.4. The starting area on Aug 27 is in Moss Landing and on other race days is in Santa Cruz. All races finish in Santa Cruz.
- 4.5. An awards ceremony will be held at the SCYC clubhouse following racing each day.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The sailing instructions will be available at the Regatta Briefing listed in the schedule, and online at Regatta Network (referenced above).

6. Venues, Courses

- 6.1. Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in the area bounded by Moss Landing to the southeast, Davenport to the northwest and extending up to ten miles off shore.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. Three races constitute a series.
- 7.2. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. Prizes

- 8.1. A daily first place prize will be awarded for each division.
- 8.2. Series prizes will be awarded at the end of the series based on number of entries in each division at the end of the first race day.
- 8.3. The winning boat in each division of three or more entries in the series will be eligible to compete in the Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions Regatta.
