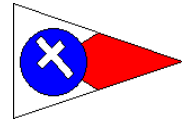

**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 Rule**

1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

**2 Eligibility and Entry**

- 2.1 Boats of the Santana 22, Moore 24 and Santa Cruz 27 One-Design classes are eligible to participate in this series. All other one-design classes may petition to participate prior to 1100 hours on Thursday, August 17, 2017.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/15063> or [scyc.org](http://scyc.org). Only on-line entries will be accepted.

**3 Fees**

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$90.00 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on Friday, August 11, 2017.
- 3.2 The late entry fee of \$110.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Friday, August 11, 2017.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1100 hours on Saturday, October 21, 2017
- 3.4 All entry fees are nonrefundable.

**4 Schedules**

- 4.1 A competitors' meeting is scheduled for 1100 hours on Saturday, August 19, 2016 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day.
- 4.3 For the Moore 24 and Santa Cruz 27 classes, nine races (9) are scheduled for the series with three (3) races each race day.
- 4.4 For the Santana 22 class, six (6) races are scheduled for the series with two (2) races each race day.
- 4.5 For all classes, four (4) races will constitute a series.
- 4.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse on Saturday, October 21<sup>st</sup>, following racing.

**5 Sailing Instructions**

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and on line at [scyc.org](http://scyc.org).

**6 Venue**

6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

**7 Courses**

7.1 A course diagram will be provided in the sailing instructions.

**8 Scoring**

8.1 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score.

**9 Prizes**

- 9.1.1 A daily first place prize will be awarded for each division.
- 9.1.2 Series prizes will be awarded at the end of the series based on the number of entries in each division.
- 9.1.3 The winning boat in each division of three (3) or more entries in the series with a current PHRF rating will be eligible to compete in the Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions Regatta.
