

NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authority is the Beverly Yacht Club.

1. Rules

1.1 The Junior Olympic Festival will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. Eligibility and Entry

- **2.1** Skippers and crew shall be 18 or younger as of December 31, 2017.
- **2.2** Skippers and crew shall be members of a SMSA member organization, or shall be invited by the Organizing Authority.
- **2.3** Skippers and crew shall be members of US Sailing or their other National Authority and provide a valid membership number at time of registration.
- 2.4 The regatta is open to the following one-design classes: Club 420, Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, O'Pen BIC and Optimist Dinghy. The organizing authority may require a minimum of six boats to constitute a class.
- **2.5** Eligible boats may register in advance on-line. The entry fee for Opti, O'Pen BIC and Laser sailors is \$85.00 per person. The entry fee for a Club 420 boat is \$170.00. Registration requires payment of the entry fee by Visa or MasterCard. Advance registration ends at 2400h on Friday, August 11th. **Facsimile registrations will not be accepted.** On-line registration with \$30 late fee will remain open through 2400h August 13th.
- **2.6** Entry fees are non-refundable, unless the class does not have sufficient entries to participate. See NOR 2.4.
- **2.7** All competitors shall check in on-site.

4. Sailing Instructions

4.1 The sailing instructions will be available during check-in; see Attachment 2.

5. Courses

- **5.1** The courses will be windward/leeward, triangles, Opti Trapezoids or O'Pen BIC course.
- **5.2** Boats sailing in the Optimist Championship fleet (red, white & blue divisions) will sail together. The Optimist green fleet (first year sailors) will sail in a separate racing area, close to the harbor.

6. Scoring

6.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

7. Prizes

- **7.1** Prizes will be awarded to each member of the crews placing first with 6 or more boats registered, second with 8 or more boats registered, third with 10 or more boats registered, and up to fifth with 14 or more boats registered.
- 7.2 USA Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to competitors placing first through third in divisions with 10 or more boats.
- **7.3** Prizes may be awarded for outstanding perseverance and for outstanding sportsmanship.
- **7.4** Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the race committee.

8. Housing

8.1 Sailors 13 years of age or older representing clubs from Cuttyhunk, Martha's Vineyard, or Nantucket may request housing by completing the "Housing Request" section of the entry form. Housing requests must be received by July 31st, 2017.

9. Safety

9.1 All competitors are required to wear a non-inflatable, USCG-approved Personal Floatation Device with a whistle attached at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while changing clothing. A boat retiring from a race shall notify a Race Committee vessel before leaving the course, or when that is impossible,

10. Competitor Behavior

10.1 Possession of or association with alcohol or drugs, the failure to comply with a reasonable request from a regatta official, a curfew violation or failure to behave in a sportsmanlike manner on or off the water may result in a RRS 69 hearing.

11. Boat Storage

11.1 All fleets will be stored and launched from Silvershell Beach, across from 19 Lewis Street, Marion. BYC personnel will be on hand, during registration hours, to direct boat placement and trailer storage. No boat storage will be provided before 1600 on Monday, August 14. Sailors planning to arrive earlier should make other arrangements for boat storage. Opti, 420, O'Pen BIC and Laser trailers can be stored at Silvershell Beach.

12. Parking

12.1 Parking passes will be available at Silvershell Beach for the duration of the regatta, including use of beach and facilities for \$10.

13. Support Boat Launch and Haul

13.1 Support boats can be launched and hauled at the Burr Brothers launch ramp at <u>309 Front Street</u>. Support Boat trailers can be stored during the regatta at the Burr Brothers Boats lot <u>366 Wareham Road</u>.

13. Decision to Race

13.1 Competitors sail at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race

14. Media Rights

14.1 By participating in this regatta, a competitor (or parent/guardian if under age 18) grants to the OA and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.
