Notice Of Race



61st North Carolina Governor's Cup Regatta June 15-17, 2018 Organizing Authority - Carolina Sailing Club

The North Carolina Governor's Cup Regatta is in its 61st year, making it one of the oldest and most venerable in the Southeast. The Regatta includes up to five races over two days. Racing takes place off Henderson Point State Recreation Area on Kerr Lake which is known for its beautiful expanse of water, tree-lined shores, great family camping, and easy access from Interstate 85.

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all one-design centerboard and catamaran classes. Invited classes include, but are not limited to:

- 2.2 Classes of fewer than 5 boats will compete under US Sailing Portsmouth handicapping rules in Open Monohull or Open Multi-hull classes.
- 2.3 All boats must have a number on their mainsail.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter online from April 1st through June 15th by going to <u>Regatta Network</u>. The link is also posted on the Club website: <u>www.carolinasailingclub.org</u>. Fees will only be accepted online using credit cards or PayPal.
- 2.5 Onsite registration will be available from 0830 until 1030 on Saturday June 16.
- 2.6 All skippers and crew must check in at the registration table <u>before</u> 1030 on Saturday June 16 to receive race materials, confirm crew, and to sign the entry/waiver form. Waiver forms for minor skippers and crew (under 18 years of age) must be signed by a parent. Forms will be available for download at the online registration site and at the event.

3. FEES

3.1 Regatta registration fees are as follows:

- 3.2 Registration fees include regatta registration, 1 dinner ticket, continental breakfasts on Saturday and Sunday, raffle tickets for skippers & crew for door prizes, and socials after sailing on Saturday and Sunday. Regatta Network requires the US Sailing Member number to be entered when registering to receive the discount. Additional dinners can be purchased as part of the registration process.
- 3.3 Extra dinners (for crew, family, friends) may be purchased at a cost of \$17 for those 12 years or older.
- 3.4 A \$7 gate fee is collected at the Henderson Point Gate House each day for those not having an annual pass.
- 3.5 Commemorative shirts will be available for purchase. Items must be ordered online before June 1st in order to be available for pickup at registration and a limited number will be available for purchase at the event.

- 4.2 A continental breakfast will be available on Saturday and Sunday mornings at the Glass House.
- 4.3 After Saturday's racing, a social with light snacks will be held for sailors and their guests. Door prizes will be awarded at the end of the social. A raffle ticket will be given to each sailor, crew member, and race committee member at registration.

- 4.4 Dinner on Saturday will be a catered buffet meal. The menu will be provided prior to the regatta. Each registration includes one dinner ticket. Extra dinners may be purchased at registration for \$17.00 for adults (12 and over). Children under 12 are free.
- 4.5 After Sunday's racing, a social with light snacks will be held prior to the awards ceremony.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing instructions will be available on Regatta Network after June 1 and also after 0830 on Saturday, June 16th at the Glass House.

6. VENUE

- 6.1 Henderson Point State Recreation Area is located on Kerr Lake near the NC-VA border approximately 15 miles north of Henderson, NC (Lat 36.32.20 North, Long 78.20.34 West). For GPS mapping programs, use "1300 Rev Henderson Rd, Henderson, NC."
- 6.2 From I-85 or US1 at Henderson, follow NC 39 north. On I-85, Hwy 39 is Exit 214. To reach Henderson Point, follow NC 39 approximately 13.5 miles north of I-85 and turn right onto Rock Springs Church Road (SR 1356). Turn right again onto Rev. Henderson Road. Signs inside the park will direct you to parking areas for the regatta.

7. THE COURSES

7.1 The course will be a "WDR" windward-leeward course with a reaching finish. A diagram of the WDR course will be included in the Sailing Instructions.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 For all multihull classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 Classes with five (5) or more boats are scored as one-design classes.
- 9.2 No scores will be excluded.
- 9.3 Rule A8.2, first sentence, is modified to read "...in the last race in which they both competed."
- 9.4 Open Monohull and Open Multihull classes will be scored using wind-adjusted Portsmouth Handicaps.
- 9.5 Race Committee personnel included in determining prizes do not count as registered boats when scoring DNC DNS, DNF, OCS, DSQ, or RET.
- 9.6 For determining the winner of the Governor's Cup, a skipper receives one point for each boat in his class that the skipper beats that finishes or is scored DNS, DNF, OCS RET, DSQ, or RC (awarded to current skipper-level CSC members serving on race committee who skipper a boat in that fleet). RC members cannot count in more than one class.

10. PRIZES

10.1 The number of trophies awarded to a class will be based on the number of boats registered in that class plus the number of skipper-level Carolina Sailing Club members in that class serving on Race Committee as follows: (1-5) 1 trophy, (6-10) 2 trophies, (11-15) 3 trophies, (16-20) 4 trophies, (21 or more) 5 trophies.

11. THE GOVERNOR'S CUP

11.1 The NC Governor's Cup is a perpetual trophy engraved with the name of the skipper having the best average score in their one-design class based on the NC Governor's Cup high-point system. A keeper trophy will also be presented to the winning skipper.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
