



**Notice of Race**

**1. Eligibility & Fees**

- 1.1 There will be starts for C420, CFJ, Laser Radial, RS Tera, Opti Championship and Opti Green.
- 1.2 A minimum of four boats is needed to constitute a fleet.
- 1.3 Results will be scored as part of the BAYS 2017 Summer Series
- 1.3 Eligible boats may enter at the following link by Thursday, July 27 at 10pm.

- 1.4 The entry fee for this regatta is \$40 per sailor. A light snack after racing will be provided.

**2. Rules**

- 2.1 The Regatta will be governed by The 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and as modified by the NOR and Sailing Instructions for this Regatta.
- 2.2 Competitors are required to carry a bowline of at least fifteen feet attached to a towing point while racing.

**3. Schedule of Events\***

Saturday, July 29, 2017

- 1000-1100: Registration & Rigging
- 1100: Competitors' Meeting
- 1230: First Race
- After Racing: Light Snack

Sunday, July 30, 2017

- 1100: Competitors' Meeting
- 1200: First Race
- 1600: No race started after this time
- 1700: Awards Presentation adjacent to PYSF classroom

\*Eight Races Scheduled for the Outside Course. All times are approximate. \*

**4. Racing Area** - The race course will be located just outside Redwood Creek for Opti Champ, C420 and Laser Radial. The Opti Green, RS Tera and CFJ Fleets will be inside the turning basin adjacent to PYSF.

**5. Coaching** - Coaching is not permitted during racing. Between races, coaching will be permitted, but coach boats shall not enter the racing area. All coach boats must also act as safety boats. Each boat must carry a VHF radio.

**6. Safety** - Each competitor must wear adequate buoyancy, properly secured at all times, on the dock and while on the water. Wet suits, dry suits and inflatable PFDs do not constitute adequate buoyancy.

**7. Liability** - Participants compete entirely at their own risk. Each competitor and their parent/guardian must sign a waiver before competing.
