

Supplementary Sailing Instructions

MYC 2017 Fall Regatta Small Boat Weekend

- 1.1 Rule 31 is changed so that boats may touch marks 2, 3, and 4,
- 1.2 The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 in an incident while *racing*.
- 1.3 All competitors shall wear USCG approved personal floatation devices with an attached whistle at all times while on the water. This changes RRS 40
- 1.4 Rule 26 is changed so that the warning signal will be made 3 minutes before the starting signal.

2.1 The official notice board is located in the upper level dining room at MYC.

4.1 The official flag pole is located on the MYC water front between the East and West docks.

5. The competitors meeting is at 1100 Saturday.

The first scheduled warning on Saturday is 1200.

The first scheduled warning on Sunday is 1100.

No race may start after 1400 on Sunday.

A total of 7 races are scheduled, one race constitutes a regatta.

6. Class Flags: C420, class logo on white flag; Laser, class logo on a white flag; Sunfish, class logo on a white flag; Open Bic, Green and White Flag.

7.1 Course diagrams and designations are shown on page 2.

8.1 Marks 1a and 5 will be orange tetrahedrons.

8.2 Marks 1b, 2, 3, and 4, will be orange cylinders.

8.3 The start mark will be a white sphere.

8.4 The finish mark will be an orange or red sphere.

8.5 Marks may be adjusted without signal as long as no boats are on that leg of the course.

12. The race time limit is 40 minutes. The Finishing window is 10 minutes.
