Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is the Melbourne Yacht Club.

Rules: This regatta is governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

Expected Classes: Expected Classes are J-24, PHRF and Marker 21 division. Boats sailing PHRF can choose to use their spinnaker or non-spinnaker rating. The race committee will divide the fleet into appropriate divisions based on the entries received. One design fleet starts will be offered for classes with 5 or more boats.

Entry and Eligibility: This Regatta is open to all monohull sailboats with an MYC issued PHRF rating. Completion of the on-line entry form and liability waver is required in order to compete. Shirts: Shirts should be pre-ordered by September 22, 2017 to insure availability. Long sleeve wicking shirts are \$20 and short sleeve are \$15.

Sailing Area: The Indian River Lagoon, south of the Melbourne Causeway.

Races: For PHRF classes, a total of five races maximum are scheduled, including one or two long-distance race, conditions permitting. A distance race counts for two short course races. Completion of 1 race constitutes a regatta. For the one-design fleets W/L courses will be offered with a total of seven races scheduled. The Marker 21 course will be given at the Competitors' meeting.

Sailing Instructions: The standard sailing instructions of RRS Appendix S will be used. The supplemental sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board located in the upper level meeting room of MYC.

Courses: Short courses will be those shown in RRS Appendix S diagram LA. The distance course diagram will be provided at registration.

Scoring: Scoring shall be per RRS Appendix A with no races excluded.

Awards: Prizes for will be awarded based upon class size for each class at the conclusion of racing on Sunday. Pirate Party awards will be presented at dinner on Saturday.
