## NOTICE OF RACE

## 1. RULES

- 1.1 The Commodore John V. Dugan, III Round the Cat Race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020 and by the GYA PHRF Regulations.
- **1.2** All entrants must have working running lights and either a VHF radio or cell phone onboard. Cell phone numbers must be included on the registration form.
- 1.3 PENALTIES AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 while racing. However, when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.'
- 1.4 PENALTIES TAKEN AFTER A RACE After a race, a boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 while racing may take a Post-Race Penalty for that incident. The penalty shall be a Scoring Penalty, calculated as stated in rule 44.3(c). However, rules 44.1(a) and (b) apply. A boat takes a Post-Race Penalty by informing the race committee in writing and identifying the race number and when and where the incident occurred.

The Post-Race Penalty shall be

- (a) 20%, if taken before the protest time limit, or
- (b) 30%, if taken after the protest time limit but before the beginning of a hearing involving the incident.
- **1.5** Other rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 2. GREEN REGATTA -- This regatta is a Clean Regatta. As such, all competitors are encouraged to use non-single use water bottles and recycle all appropriate items. Competitors are reminded of rule 55 that states that competitors "shall not intentionally put trash in the water."

- **3. FEES -** The entry fee is \$ 55.00 per boat. A \$5.00 deduction is allowed to current US SAILING members.
- **4. CLASSES** PHRF Spinnaker class will be scored if three or more boats register in class. Entries are limited to seaworthy yachts not less than 20 feet LOA. Yachts that compete in the Spinnaker class must have a current GYA / PHRF rating certificate.

- **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS -** The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.
- 7. COURSES The course for the PHRF Spinnaker class will be around Cat Island with a total distance of approximately 28 NM. Weather conditions may require that the Spinnaker class use the inside Cat Island course for a total distance of approximately 16 NM. Specific courses and marks are provided on a separate course sheet.
- **8. PRIZES** Prizes will be awarded to competitors as follows:

Five boats registered First and Second Places

Six boats registered First, Second and Third Places
