NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*.
- 1.2 The US Sailing prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 The HYRA prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted as follows: No Restrictions.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the PHRF Monohull A class provided that a current or past Commodore of an established Yacht Club in the state of Hawaii is the driver of the racing yacht.
- 3.1(a) A class PHRF > 50
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form, together with the required fee, available at regattanetwork.com:

- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Online registration prior to the first warning signal of the day of racing.

7.2 Skippers meeting at the LYC Dock Box slip 42 1000

7.3 The scheduled time of the 5-minute warning signal for first race **1155**. The RC will sound a horn approximately 1 minute prior to the 5-minute sequence.

7.4 Number of races: A Minimum of three races per day are scheduled. A maximum of 6 races may be held

7.5 After racing party at the LYC 1630-1800

8 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid **PHRF** rating certificate if requested.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available online at: a minimum of 12 hours prior to the first warning signal.

10 VENUE

10.1 Racing shall be offshore Lahaina in the approximate area of Puamana or Launiopoko.

11 THE COURSES

The diagrams in Attachment A show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. The approximate TOTAL course length will be no less than 1.5 NM for all Classes.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM – Rule 44: Penalties taken at the time of incident

12.1 For the A class rule 44.1 is Un-changed: The Two-Turns Penalty is in effect.

12.3 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

13 SCORING

13.1 The scoring system is as follows: Low Point System of Appendix A.

13.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 13.3
- (a) When 3 or fewer races have been completed; a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from 4 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

14 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall notify the Race Committee and monitor the Race Channel 71

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Race Committee will monitor VHF Channel 71

19 PRIZES/PARTIES

19.1 The Winner of the event will have their name added to the Ron Wall Perpetual Trophy as per the Deed of Gift of the Ron Wall Memorial Trophy.

19.2 Post Racing Parties – The Lahaina Yacht Club will provide pupu and drinks after racing concludes on race day. Skippers need to provide crew head counts at the skippers meeting to receive drink chips (1 per crew).

20 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

21 INSURANCE

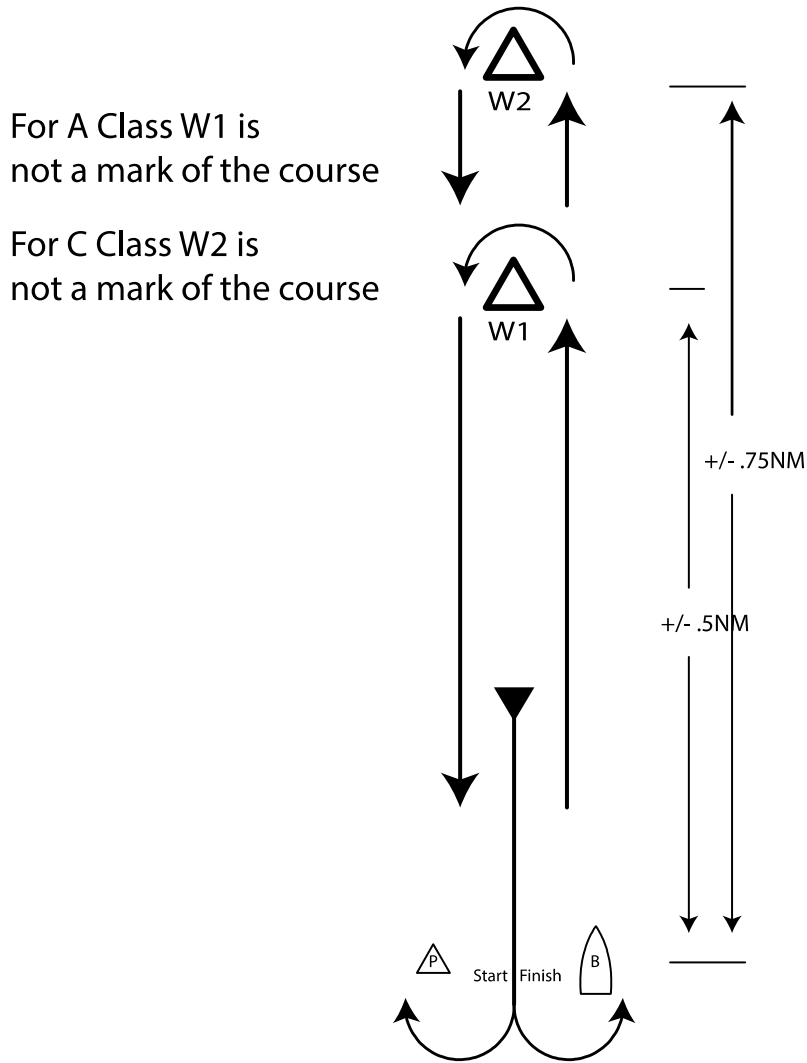
Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

The race committee will never lengthen a race once a race has started, but at their discretion may shorten a race by flying the "S" flag and the new course flag as competitors Pass through the Gate.
