Notice of Race *Mesick Regatta*

October 28 – November 4, 2017

Organizing Authority: Hawaii Yacht Club (HYC)

1. RULES

1.1. The race will be conducted according to *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, (RRS)* including US Sailing Prescriptions, excluding the prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, 63.4; and Hawaii Yacht Racing Association [HYRA] Prescriptions unless otherwise amended in this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category C as per ISAF Regulation 20.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts that meet requirements for ISAF Offshore Special Regulations Category 4 and are members of HYRA member clubs, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authorities. Yachts that participate in the night race shall meet ISAF Offshore Special Regulations Category 3.

3.2. Eligible yachts may enter via the US Sailing RegattaNetwork website between October 23 and 26, 2017, 2000 hrs. Entries will only be accepted using the RegattaNetwork website <http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.html>.

3.3 Yachts may be denied entry by the organizing authority.

4. FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

4.2 Late entries will be assessed an additional fee of \$10.

6. MEASUREMENTS

6.1. Each boat shall have a valid Performance Handicap Racing Fleet [PHRF] handicap certificate or be assigned a temporary handicap.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be offered at the skipper's meeting, on Regattanetwork.com. or posted at HYC lower deck sailing board.

8. COURSE

The Course will be in the waters offshore Waikiki (Mamala Bay Races), and in the waters offshore Waikiki (Distance Race). Saturday's race is Kokohead. Sunday's race is Windward and Leeward.

9. SCORING

9.1. Corrected times will be calculated using the PHRF scoring system, as adopted by the Hawaii Yacht Racing Association [HYRA].

9.2. The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply without modification.

9.3. Mesick Regatta: All three races.

9.4. HYRA Season's Points: Top three races total score.

10. PRIZES

For each class, 1st prize will be awarded if at least 3 boats enter, 2nd prize will be awarded if at least 5 boats enter, and 3rd prize will be awarded if at least 7 boats enter.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per event or the equivalent.
