#### 1 Rules

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), including the prescriptions of US Sailing, except as noted and changed by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 USCG approved life jackets must be worn while on the water.

#### 2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Registration will be available on Regatta Network and also onsite the morning of competition.
- 2.2 Race is open to all boats with a valid Portsmouth rating.
- 2.3 Any modifications a competitor makes to a boat that violates its class's rules must make note of the modification on the registration application.

#### 3 Fees – Save \$20! Please register online BY 11/17 to receive discount, however, DO NOT pay until day of race at check in. Checks or cash accepted. Sorry, no credit cards.

Adult Multi-Crew: \$45 (Early registration fee - \$25 by 11/17).

Adult Singlehanded: \$35 (Early registration fee - \$15 by 11/17).

Youth Sailors (17 years and younger): \$30 (Early registration fee - \$10 by 11/17)

#### 5 Venue

Racing will be on and around the Intracoastal Waterway, locally known as the Halifax River, between Orange Avenue Bridge and the Dunlawton Bridge.

#### 6 Course

The course for the distance race will be approximately 8 miles. The specific details for the distance course will be covered during the skippers meeting.

#### 7 Scoring

- 7.1 The distance race will be comprised of only one race. Each boat's time will be corrected time in accordance with the Portsmouth rating of that boat.

#### 8 Awards

- 8.1 Awards will be given to the top boat in each class: centerboard dinghy, keelboat, and multihull.
- 8.2 A Turkey, a chicken, and a Cornish game-hen will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall respectively.
- 8.3 The fastest boat scored on corrected time with an LOA > 21ft will be awarded the Stargazer Trophy
- 8.4 The fastest boat scored on corrected time with an LOA < 21ft will be awarded the Chris Baker Trophy

#### 9 Disclaimer of Liability

All competitors will be required to sign a waiver of liability as a condition of entry. Parents/guardians must sign for competitors under 18.
