### Let's make the check in process easy:

- 1. Both skipper and crew are required to be members of the Hobie Class Association of North America. Sign up online: <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/membermgmt/</u> <u>HCANA/membership\_registration\_start.php</u>
- 2. Make sure you have liability insurance as stated in the Sailing Instructions.
- 3. For youth, complete the liability and waiver form and **email** it to <u>dafnabrown@gmail.com</u>. Here's the form: <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/</u> <u>clubmgmt/regatta\_uploads/15801/2018NAYOUTHliabilityandmedicalforms.pdf</u>
- 4. For youth: you must be under the age of 21 and not turn 21 in 2018.
- 5. Reminder: the minimum crew weight for youth is 250 lbs. and for women it is 260 lbs.
- 6. Please complete skipper and crew information on Regatta Network.

### Good to know:

Prepare for the altitude: drink plenty of water as you head up the mountain!

Weather: warm days and cool nights. Water is chilly.

Bring: pads/carpet for boat storage on concrete parking lot, beach wheels, sun protection, wetsuit, warm jacket for when the sun goes down, and beach chair for the campfire.

Awards Banquet on Friday night will require purchase of a dinner ticket (\$20) for noncompetitors. Tickets will be available at Check-In.

Lots of viewing potential for spectators from the Race Committee Point. See map.

For campers, registration is offsite at the USFS Visitor Center on Kaiser Pass Road.

Cell phone coverage is spotty. AT&T and Verizon work, but not T-mobile. Most condos and/or vacation homes do not provide access to a wireless network. Bring a hotspot if you need it.

Lakeshore Resort has a small convenience store, restaurant and bar. Shaver Lake has more food options but it's a 30 min drive from Huntington Lake.

Explore! Take a short hike to Rancheria Falls. Drive up to Kaiser Pass for a beautiful view.
