1. Organizing Authority & Host

Treasure Coast Youth Sailing Foundation

2. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

3. Eligibility & Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Optimist class (including wood, plastic and fiberglass hulls), Collegiate 420 (ie No spinnaker or trapeze) and Open Bic. They will race and be scored in 4 classes; 1) Optimist Gold class will consist of Optimist sailors with 1.5 years or more of sailing experience, 2) all other Optimist sailors will sail in the Silver class, 3) a 420 class, and 4) an Open Bic.
- 3.2 Eligible crews may be entered by registering through Regatta Network at:

4. Registration & Fees

- 4.1 All competitors must check in on Sunday, February 25, 2018 between the hours of 11:00 and 12:00 a.m.

Youth: \$20 single-handed \$30 double-handed

Adult: \$30 single-handed \$40 double-handed

5. Schedule of Events

First race immediately following Skipper's Meeting

No starts after 1600

Recognition Ceremony following racing

Family cook out available following ceremony.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available during the skippers meeting.

7. Courses

Courses will consist of triangles for the Optimist classes and Open Bic class, and windward/leeward for 420's. We will use 3-minute sound sequence start.

8. Scoring

One race constitutes a regatta.

9. Prizes

Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each class.

10. Snacks during racing

Coaches and families are encouraged to bring their own snacks and water during sailing.

11. Safety

All competitors shall wear U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets at all times while on the water.

12. Directions to Jaycee Park

From US1 in Fort Pierce, take Seaway Drive across the intercoastal bridge to Hutchinson Island. Turn right onto Ocean Drive. You will see "Kimberly Bergalis Memorial Park" on the left and Jaycee Park will be on the right. Turn right on Malaleuca Dr. and go to the end. Parking is in this area on the right. The boat house is located on the water, north of the parking area.
