## Lake Ray Hubbard Lakewide PHRF Ratings Application Information and Contacts

For the Lake Ray Hubbard Lakewide PHRF ratings, we've been using the mean rating from U.S. Sailing's PHRF Handicaps book as the starting point. For the initial base rating, we need to know the make, model and any critical rig options (e.g. tall mast, bow sprit, etc) for the boat.

We've simplified the PHRF rating adjustments for the Lakewide PHRF ratings to the bare minimum.

- 1. Roller Furler w/UV (only 1 Genoa used and attached approx 2ft above deck = +6)
- 2. Genoa (>170%= -6; 170%-155%= -3; <140%= +3)
- 3. Spinaker Pole (>J= -3)
- 4. Propeller (2-blade fixed= +3; 3-blade fixed= +6)

Let us know which of the adjustments apply and we'll update the ratings database.
