NOTICE OF RACE

1. Organizing Authority The organizing authority is the Contender Class of NA

2. Venue

2.1 The regatta venue is Clearwater Community Sailing Center (CCSC), 1001 Gulf Blvd., Clearwater, FL 33767 (727) 517-7776, www.clearwatercommunitysailing.org

2.2 The racing area will be to the north of Clearwater Pass, in the Gulf of Mexico, with the option to race in the inside bay off the sailing center.

3. Rules The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (except as changed by this notice of race or the sailing instructions), the prescriptions of US SAILING, the rules of the International Contender Class, this notice of race, and the sailing instructions.

4. Eligibility

The regatta is restricted to Contender class boats.

5. Registration

5.1 Competitors may register online at the CCSC website, no later than February 6th. Entry forms may also be mailed.

5.2 Registration will be on Wednesday, February 8th, at the CCSC from 0800 hrs to 0900 hrs.

5.3 Completed entry forms, and fees must be received no later than 0900 hrs Wednesday 2/7/2018.

Signed liability waivers, entry forms, and fees must be received no later than 0900 hours, February 7th.

Waivers can be executed online or at check-in.

6. Entry Fee

6.1 Entry fee includes three days of racing, and two evening meals.

6.2 Entry fee will be \$100. Checks should be made out to CCSC.

The courses will be either windward/leeward, with finishes to leeward, triangle WL, or the Harry Anderson course, modified. Number of windward legs will be shown on the RC Signal boat. Final details will be in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

10. Advertising

This event will be governed by the RRS, Appendix 1, Regulation 20.

11. Scoring

The Low Point Score System of RRS, Appendix A will apply.

12. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the skippers placing first, second, and third.

13. Disclaimer

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the organizing authority nor the host organization, nor the sponsors will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
